Introduction: Dr. Geetha J. Kamath, M.D.

Dr. Geetha Kamath came to Swami's fold when she was only 8 years old. Swami has played a very big role in her life, whether it is becoming a doctor, her marriage or practice of medicine. She had the privilege of getting direct guidance regarding service activities during her multiple interviews with Swami.

She is a practicing Hematologist and Oncologist in St. Petersburg, Florida since 1981. She participated in yearly Medical Camps during Swami's birthday celebration in Prashanthi Nilayam, since 1975. For the past 15 years, she has participated in Guru Purnima and Birthday Camps in Prashanthi Nilayam.

She started conducting annual screening camps in St. Petersburg, Florida, starting in 2004. In 2008 she converted the screening camps into treatment camps. The treatment camps included, Dental Hygiene, Dental treatment, Eye and Podiatry Camps. In addition, she participates once a month in a Saturday Medical clinic at the St. Petersburg Free Clinic.
